

### Commander's Message



Membership – Renewal 2024 is at a remarkable **379 members** making our percentage at **105.7**%. There are still many members who have not renewed. For the sake of our Post Membership Program, if you don't have a card that states **2024**, you are delinquent in your dues and free insurance. Please renew as soon as possible.

MOH recipient Roger Donlon passes away - Retired Army Col. Roger Donlon, the first Medal of Honor recipient of the Vietnam War, passed away Jan. 25. He was 89. On July 6, 1964, then-Capt. Donlon was the commanding officer at Camp Nam Dong, Vietnam, when a Viet Cong battalion launched a pre-dawn attack. During the next five hours, Donlon repeatedly exposed himself to heavy fire while defending against the enemy, moving ammunitions and weaponry to effective positions, aiding the wounded and rallying his men.

Throughout the battle, he was severely injured several times but persevered and insisted others receive medical attention before him. When the sun finally came up, the enemy retreated into the jungle. Donlon's bravery and leadership had resulted in the defeat of the attackers and preserving the lives of the friendly Vietnamese camp defenders and fellow Americans. Donlon, a longtime member of American Legion Post 172 in New York, was also the first veteran of the Vietnam War to receive The American Legion's Distinguished Service Medal in 1966.

One year, \$18.8 billion in veteran's benefits claims - There are more than 18 billion reasons why our nation's veterans gave thanks to The American Legion during Fiscal Year 2023, which ended in September. That's because American Legion accredited service officers secured nearly 19 billion dollars — \$18,800,997,141.62 to be precise — in benefits claims for veterans. That amount exceeds the \$16 billion that veterans received in the previous fiscal year. (This why you should be part of the American Legion)
