



Commander's Message



Membership – Renewal 2024 is at a remarkable 226 members making our percentage at 63.6%. Please get your dues to the Post or pay online. Either way, the Post gets the credit and you the satisfaction of supporting your Post during this annual membership run.

American Legion News – VA partners with DoD to increase surgery access for Gulf Coast Veterans - The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) announced a new partnership with the Department of Defense to increase access to world-class surgical care for approximately 37,000 Gulf Coast-area veterans. Under this new agreement, these veterans will now be able to receive same-day, outpatient surgical care at a new VA clinic in Naval Hospital Pensacola — a local DoD hospital.

3.2% COLA – Military retirees and veterans can expect a 3.2% cost-of-living adjustment in their retirement pay and veterans disability pay. This is the same increase provided in Social Security, and it was calculated by the Labor Department's Bureau of Labor Statistics based on changes in consumer prices.

What to Watch: Military members and federal workers would receive a 5.2% pay increase under the 2024 budget pending before Congress. This increase is calculated to keep pace with private sector pay. The increase for retirees and veterans should first appear in December pay, while the military raise would take effect Jan. 1.

Veterans Day – Buddy Check – November 11th, 2023 – Buddy Check - American Legion posts are also strongly encouraged, by resolution, to make Buddy Check calls during **Veterans Week** (*mid-November*) and **American Legion Birthday Week** (*mid-March*). If you know a Vet, please check on him/her wellbeing and if needed, turn the name, address, and phone number to be included in our monthly Buddy Check System.
