
































Commander's Message

Family members or (grand)children contacting someone and sound urgent that money be done quickly, they are in trouble and need help now. At the store or Emergency room and need your debit or credit card information to complete a transaction. They forgot their wallet or card and ask you to help. Once you have given your card number and information, they will need the three-digit code. Once someone has all that information they can go to town with your card. They have all the information to purchase online, everywhere.
