VA's Board of Veterans Appeals; is celebrating its 92<sup>nd</sup> birthday on July 28, 2025. The Board is celebrating this milestone by surpassing 92,000 dispatched disability appeals for Veterans and dependents faster this year than ever before. The Board remains on track this Fiscal Year to issue the highest annual number of decisions in its history. The creation of the Board was confirmation that VA would not forget those who sacrificed so much for all our freedoms. Thus, the Board's primary mission was clear and simple: Fulfill the Nation's promise to Veterans by upholding the values of justice and fairness to ensure that those who sacrificed so much for this Nation would be cared for with dignity and respect.

"Under President Trump, the Board's decision productivity is the highest it has ever been, averaging nearly 2,550 decisions issued every week, and reducing the number of pending Veteran and dependent appeals to 169,747, the lowest level since September 2020. We will continue working hard on behalf of Veterans," said VA Secretary Doug Collins. "Veterans and VA beneficiaries deserve timely and accurate appeals decisions, and that is exactly what we will deliver to them."

Pension poaching: VA pension and <u>survivors' pension</u> are income-based benefits which are frequently targeted by bad actors in a scam called 'Pension Poaching'. Pension poaching is a financial scam where bad actors advise Veterans to transfer assets or add unnecessary home health care expenses so they can adjust their income to qualify for VA pension or survivors pension benefits. Obtaining VA benefits through deceptive practices may require Veterans (and not the bad actor) to repay any falsified amounts. If a Veteran needs assistance filing a claim for <u>VA benefits or services</u>, they should work with a <u>VA accredited Veterans Service Organization</u> representative, attorney or claims agent.


